Subject:-Grant of Conditional Permission with reduction in intake capacity to T.M.A.E Society's Ayurvedic Medical College, Sankalapura, Tanda, Ballary, Road, Hospet-583201, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0060) with intake capacity of 54 seats [instead of 60 seats] in UG (BAMS) course and 03 Seats in 01 PG course in the subject namely i) Shalya tantra, under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25- regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **T.M.A.E Society's Ayurvedic Medical College, Sankalapura, Tanda, Ballary, Road, Hospet-583201, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0060)**, inspection of your college was conducted on **05.02.2024 & 06.02.2024 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 03 Seats in 01 PG course in the subject namely i) Shalya tantra for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is not fulfilling the notified and approved criteria due to the following shortcoming:-**

3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **96th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **05.07.2024**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above, **the Board discussed and decided to provide an opportunity of virtual hearing** vide the MARB-ISM letter (Hearing notice) of

even number dated **11.07.2024** to appear before the designated Hearing Committee on **15.07.2024**, to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the Conditional permission to the college with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) and 03 Seats in 01 PG course in the subject namely i) Shalya tantra under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 be denied for the academic year 2024-25**. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter no. TMAES/BAMS/182/2024-25 dated 13.07.2024** against the deficiencies conveyed to them.

4. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Dr. Manonmani L, Principal**, appeared before the Hearing Committee on **15.07.2024** and made their submission virtually as well as written, against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

Principal submitted that, no HF in Ayurveda Samhita Siddhanta, Kriya Sharir and Kaya Chikitsa. Stated that appointments will be made as soon as possible. 01 LF has been appointed in Kriya Sharir dept after the visitation. Hence, submission made by the principal is not considered.

Hence, Shortcoming persists.

6. Further, the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and the Board observed that the college **is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the academic Session 2024-25. However, the Board decided to issue Conditional Permission for the UG course as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the academic year 2024-25, wherein it is mentioned that:-**

a. "For deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10 % of total intake capacity."

Accordingly as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to sixty intake capacity shall not exceed more than ten percent of total requirement. As per the Hearing Committee observation and approval of Minutes in the 98th Board meeting of MARBISM, college is having only **26 total eligible teaching faculties.**

There is deficiency of **01 teacher** for issuance of **Conditional Permission** for academic session 2024-25 as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of MSR 2016. **Therefore, in accordance with seat reduction policy 2024-2025, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity.**

Hence, after applying the seat reduction policy 2024-25 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Conditional Permission with 54 seats [instead of 60 seats] in UG (BAMS) course and 03 Seats in each 01 PG course namely i) Shalya tantra for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

7. Therefore, **Conditional Permission is granted to T.M.A.E Society's Ayurvedic Medical College, Sankalapura, Tanda, Ballary, Road, Hospet-583201, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0060), with intake capacity of 54 seats [instead of 60 seats] in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020** subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following **conditions as mentioned below: -**

I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of **54 seats [instead of 60 seats]** and that minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted **03 Seats in 01 PG course** shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

9. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**

10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

5. Thereafter, the observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2022 and relevant regulations thereunder, **and once again** the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the **98th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) **on 19.07.2024.**

11. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to the MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-2026:

- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
- ii) All the requirements of minimum standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in MES (Assessment & Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
- iv) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
- v) The shortcoming mentioned in **Para no. 4** above, should be fulfilled.

12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.

13. The letter of even number dated 14.08.2024 hereby stands withdrawn.
